Here are the requirements for being a volunteer: you are at least 18 years of age; not allergic to pets; you complete this application and present it with a copy of your police record, which can be obtained at your local courthouse.

\_\_\_\_\_ Fence Building for dogs on chains - work with a team for 2-3 hours, usually on weekends, to build a fence large enough for a dog to run and play. Materials and supplies provided.
